




Jeonbuk National University

Jeonbuk National University is the first national university established in the southern region of South Korea. Reborn as a university that is based on empathy and innovation, JBNU has been a prestigious university that has led development on a regional and national basis. Its main campus is located in Jeonju, the most 'Korean-like' city in South Korea. There are also seven operating departments located at the Iksan campus, including Agriculture & Life Sciences and Veterinary Medicine.

Korean Language Education Center

Jeonbuk National University Korean Language Education Center (JBNU KLEC) offers Korean language classes for foreigners to help students have a good command of Korean in terms of fluency and accuracy and comprehend Korean culture. JBNU KLEC aims to help students acquire a high level of Korean proficiency, enabling them to enroll in a degree program after completing the course.



Korean Language Program

- Systematic curriculum based on students' level of proficiency (level 1~level 6)
- Skillful lecturers with extensive teaching experience
- Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) preparation through an integrated course consisting of listening, speaking, reading, writing, vocabulary, and grammar

Admission Process

Document screening	 Decision made will be based on academic ability [based on the documents, self-introduction, study plan] (40 points) and attitude & basic knowledge (60 points)
Successful applicants, invoice issuance	 Successful applicants will be notified personally by email. Successful applicants must submit the certified original documents by mail.
Tuition fee payment	Deposit the exact amount to the virtual account specified in the invoice
Certificate of Admission issuance	 Certificate of Admission will be sent to successful applicants who have submitted certified original documents and have completed the tuition fee payment.
Visa application	 Apply for a visa at the Korean Embassy (please check the required documents for visa application before visiting)
Beginning of semester	Entry to Korea and participate in the class

Required Documents for Admission

- * Required documents must be submitted during the online application process after being converted into electronic files. The Certificate of Admission will only be issued to successful applicants who have submitted all certified original documents by mail or in person and have completed the tuition fee payment.
- * Documents in other languages other than Korean or English must be translated to Korean or English. Please submit the translated documents or the notarized documents.

For non-notarized translated documents, please also submit 'translator confirmation letter' and graduation certificate of the translator.

- * Submitting forged and false documents may result in admission revocation.
- * Additional documents may be requested during the document screening process, and the submitted documents will not be returned.

School life

Neul-beot Do-u-mi

One-on-one tutoring program where one Korean Language Program student will be paired with one JBNU Korean student to help them improve their Korean language skills and adjust better to Korean life.

Korean Classroom

One-on-one offline tutoring program with a Korean teacher to help students improve basic Korean communication skills and Korean writing skills.



Cultural activity

Students can experience Korean culture that will help them understand and adapt better to the culture.

Support service for tasks related to immigration office

KLEC helps students with Alien Registration Card (Foreigner Registration Card) issuance, visa extension, change of visa type, and etc.



Dormitory

- 2 people per room / 3 meals per day provided (except for weekends and national holidays)
- Facilities inside the room: desk, chair, wardrobe, AC, toilet, bathroom
- Public facilities: reading room, computer room, lounge, gym, laundry room, convenience store, stationery store, cafe, restaurant, etc.
- Fee : ±1,000,000 KRW / 3 months

Insurance

Every international students must have insurance during their stay in Korea. KLEC provides students with information about National Health Insurance, including on how to sign up and file an insurance claim.

- Up to 6 months after entry : Group insurance for international students (±100,000 KRW/2 semesters)
- 6 months after entry to Korea : automatic sign-up for National Health Insurance (±70,000 KRW/month)

Other Korean language programs

Korean Conversation Course

A course that helps students improve their Korean skills and their understanding of Korean culture through various topics related to everyday life.

- Target: JBNU international students and foreigners who reside in Korea
- Level: Level 1~5
- Application method: online application (https://wz3.jbnu.ac.kr/lec_korean/index.do
 → Click'Conversation Course Application Form')
- Course time : 70 hours (Spring-Fall semester: 1 hour per day for 14 weeks) / (Summer-Winter semester: 2 hours per day for 7 weeks)
- Tuition fee: 450,000 KRW
- * The completion certificate of Korean Conversation Course can be used as a substitute for the foreign language test certificate requirement (only applicable to some departments)

Test of Proficiency in Korean (TOPIK) Preparation Class

Test preparation class that focuses on solving TOPIK sample questions.

- Target: JBNU international students and foreigners who reside in Korea
- Level : Intermediate/Advanced (±20 students)
- Application period : 2 weeks before the test date
- Application method: Google Forms
- Course period: 2 weeks (20 hours)
- Tuition fee : 130,000 KRW

Interview Preparation Class

By joining this class, students can practice in a mock interview and learn the appropriate manner and etiquette in preparation for JBNU undergraduate or graduate school admission interview

- Target: Students who are planning to apply to JBNU undergraduate or graduate school
- Application method: Google Forms
- Course period: TBA
